ASK THE EXPERT

Hair guru Cristophe explains how to cut and coddle your hair

Q Is it possible to reverse damage?

A Once hair is split you can't do anything except cut off the ends. You must proactively take care of your hair to avoid future breakage. Some hair types, like fine hair, are naturally more prone to breaking. The best advice is to use a good thermal reconstructer (like Cristophe Beverly Hills Restorative Hair Mask, \$10, CVS stores), which helps to restore strength without weighing hair down. Also, you can fake healthy hair during the restorative process with shine-enhancing pomades and serums.

Q Does every hair type look better with layers?

A Every haircut can be layered to a certain degree if it is adjusted for a person's hair type. It is really all about balance. You need to consider face shape, bone type and hair quality.

Q What are your favorite fall hair trends?

A This season we'll see a transition from short and layered cuts to more polished looks. But hair shouldn't appear over-styled. The number one mistake that women make is to overwork hair or coax it into a look that isn't natural-looking. Light styling with minimal products should be all that's needed.
